Purpose: To support research activities related to native vegetation conservation.

Overview: While the Council is willing to consider research proposals that will enhance our knowledge regarding the conservation and management of native vegetation in South Australia, it assesses applications against the following criteria:

- outcomes that inform and assist in the development of native vegetation policy by the Council
- outcomes leading to improved management of native vegetation and/or conservation status of species or communities
- specific recommendations aimed at improving some aspect of habitat or biodiversity conservation.

Funding is available for biodiversity projects that will assist in conservation, restoration and management of native vegetation in South Australia.

Limitations: Please note: This program supports research. Projects seeking on ground restoration works will not be funded through this program.

Purpose: To provide funding for research into the conservation, restoration and management of native vegetation.

Overview: Funding is available for biodiversity projects that will assist in the large scale conservation, restoration and management of native vegetation across Natural Resource Management (NRM) Regions at a landscape scale. The NVC will consider applications that develop partnerships that look at conservation enhancement and landscape management. Projects should address NVC priorities and be consistent with strategies and priorities identified in the regional NRM plans.

Examples: NVC priorities include:

- The enhancement of remnant native vegetation through the implementation of active management activities
- Assisting in achieving targets identified in the Nature Links program or established Nature Links corridors
- Assisting in the rehabilitation, protection and management of key areas identified through biodiversity analysis
- Provision for long term biodiversity outcomes, such as addressing potential impacts of climate change.
- Assisting in the conservation of National, State or Regionally listed plant species and vegetation communities
- Assisting in the enhancement of biodiversity to meet targets established in the regional NRM Plans and regional Biodiversity Plans.

Limitations: Deficit funding, travel, individuals, general fundraising appeals.
